God gives the gift of life

When Peter asks Jesus to wash his hands and head as well (all the exposed part of His body), Jesus answers: "He who is bathed needs only to wash his feet, but is completely clean, and you are clean, but not all of you (Judas)." Then we are taught to do the same for each other. "He who is bathed", is the person who has received eternal life, being washed in the blood of Jesus.



This manual is meant to be a help to the Body of Christ to "wash each others feet" of the dust that has attached itself to our feet along the dusty roads of our lives.

It is not meant to be a "quick fix" – and then we just continue a lifestyle dishonoring our Lord (1 Corinthians 6:20). However, we have found there is a definite need of a structured tool, which can help the new believers (sometimes old believers too) to bring victory in their lives.

Some of us have never received prayer for healing and deliverance. We often pray with people and our hearts are crying because we see the pain and tremendous suffering many of them have been under for many years because of bondage or a curse that could have been broken at the point of salvation.

For some ten years ago, one of Sweden's most famous evangelists Frank Mangs at an old age, after a vision from the Lord, repented to all the Christians in his country because he realized he had not fulfilled his calling. He confessed he had taken the sinners only to the gate of repentance and salvation but then left them without bringing them through deliverance as well.



Writing this is an effort and a desire to see no one left out on their own to deal with areas of personal warfare of which the Body of Christ is called to help and support each other (James 5:16).
